Rules of Decorum

- Meetings of the Tulare Cemetery District shall be conducted in an orderly manner to ensure that the public has a full opportunity to be heard and that the deliberative process of the Trustees is retained at all times.
- No person in the audience at a District meeting shall engage in disorderly, boisterous conduct or other acts which disturb, disrupt or otherwise impede the orderly conduct of any District meeting.
- The Chair shall request that a person who is breaching the rules of decorum be orderly and silent. If, after receiving a warning from the Chair, a person persists in disturbing the meeting, the Chair shall order him or her, to leave the District meeting.
- If such person does not remove himself or herself, the Penal Code provides that every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any meeting, not unlawful in its character, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Addressing the Cemetery Board

- No person shall address the Trustees without first being recognized by the Chair.
- Each person shall confine his or her remarks to the agenda item.
- Each person shall limit his or her remarks for business items or oral communications to three minutes, with a total of 15 minutes allotted for the Public Comment Period unless further time is granted by the Chair.
- All remarks shall be addressed to the Trustees as a whole and not to any single member thereof, unless in response to a question from such member.
- No question may be asked of the Trustees without permission of the Chair.

Trustee Conduct

- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees agree to disagree.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees when desiring to speak shall address the Chair and confine their remarks to the questions under debate.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will use respectful language, will not shout nor use aggressive behavior when communicating ideas, beliefs or comments.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will not allow personal attacks on staff, each other, or the public.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will not condone issues brought before the board that warrant public review without allowing the staff to review the situation and/or permission to add to the board agenda. Issues that warrant review, discussion and/or consideration of the legislative body shall be presented at an open and public meeting in a courteous and professional manner.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will not condone grandstanding.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will not belabor issues that have either been resolved or tabled to ensure continued productive discussions and decisions.
- The Tulare Public Cemetery Trustees will be proactive in addressing disagreements with fellow members or staff by directly addressing concerns with that member through meaningful and respectful dialogue.

AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE
Burial Rights, Endowment Care, Merchandise and Services

THIS CONTRACT is executed in this Day of June, 2021, by and between Tulare Public Cemetery District of Tulare County doing business as Tulare Public Cemetery District and North Tulare Cemetery, County of Tulare, State of California, hereinafter called "SELLER", and _____, residing at _____, in the City of Tulare, State of CA, hereinafter called "Buyer".

SELLER agrees to sell, and BUYER (jointly and severally, if more than one) hereby agrees to buy, subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the following described burial rights, endowment care, merchandise and services, to wit:

PAYMENTS shall be paid by BUYER in FULL.

BUYER and SELLER further agree as follows:

1. A Certificate of Interment Rights to said property shall not pass to BUYER until the contract balance and other sums due hereunder are fully paid in full. No interment in said property will be allowed until the contract balances and other sums due are fully paid
2. The BUYER agrees that said interment rights are purchased for use and not for speculation or investment. BUYER further agrees and understands that any additional service, merchandise, additions, changes or needs not listed in said contract will require payment 24 working hours before the use of the contract, these additions which may include, but will not be limited to:
 - a. If the interment of the deceased is eligible for burial, but is not a resident of the District and owned no property in the District at the time of death, a non-resident fee will be charged before the burial is made.
 - b. If a burial is made on Saturday the overtime fee will be paid before the burial is made.
 - c. If at the time of burial an oversize outer burial container is determined to be needed to accommodate the casket, an additional fee will be required for the oversize container and if necessary, an additional lot.

3. *The conveyance and succession for said interment rights shall be subject to the California Health and Safety Code Section 9069, Chapter 5.5, Interment Rights and all SELLERS rules and regulations which may be duly adopted in policies, rules, and regulations for governing the use, sale, or other transfer of interment rights.*
4. *If the BUYER is deceased and said contract have not been used for interment, substantial service or merchandise, and have not been sold or gifted by the BUYER, said rights will succeed in the order of Assignment Designation. If no assigned designee makes claim on said interment rights, they shall pass according to the laws of intestate succession as set forth in Section 6400 to 6413, inclusive of the California Probate Code.*
5. If this contract is terminated by the BUYER, the SELLER will refund all amounts paid hereunder with the exception of \$ _____, which includes any and all Endowment Care and Service Charges (if paid) which shall be retained by the SELLER.
6. BUYER shall have the right any time, unless in default hereunder to assign his interest in this agreement to an eligible person, provided such assignment is first recorded on the books of the SELLER and transferred according to the rules and regulations as required by the SELLER.
7. No warranties, expressed or implied, representations, promises, or statements have been made by the SELLER unless endorsed hereon in writing. This agreement contains all the covenants and promises between the parties, and no agent or representative of either party has authority to modify, add or change any of the terms and conditions herein set forth nor the term or conditions of the receipt of payment.
8. This agreement shall become effective when signed by and authorized official of the SELLER and thereafter it shall apply to and bind and insure to the benefit of the SELLER and the heirs, administrators, executors and assigns of the BUYER, and whenever the BUYER is mentioned herein, it shall include the heirs and assigns of the BUYER as they were specifically designated by the Burial Rights Successor-Affidavit.
9. You, the purchaser, may cancel this transaction at any time prior to midnight of the fifth (5th) calendar day after the date of this transaction, provided no interment, substantial service or merchandise has been provided hereunder. To cancel, deliver or mail written notice of your intent to Tulare Public Cemetery District, 900 East Kern Avenue, Tulare,

TULARE PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICT FLOWER POLICY

The following are guidelines for the use of flowers and decorations on the grave sites in the Tulare Public Cemetery District, in order to maintain the cemeteries in an attractive and dignified manner and in order to protect the safety of visitors and the employees on the cemeteries.

FLOWERS AND DECORATIONS MUST BE CONFINED WITHIN THE VASE HOLDERS ON EACH GRAVE SITE MARKER BORDER

There shall not be placed on any grave, crosses, balloons, fences cement vases, borders of the flowers, rocks, wood, metal, statues, toys, decorations, etc, unless they are confined and secured as an integral part of the flower arrangement within the vase holders above the grave site marker. Anyone who does not have a marker/headstone cannot have anything on the grave until a marker /headstone is set.

Cemetery staff will remove any of the arrangement that become wilted, tattered, a hazard, or safety issue to anyone visiting the Cemetery.

Tulare Public Cemetery District will take reasonable efforts not to harm arrangements within the site containers and will not be responsible for anything that has broken, lost, stolen misplaced or vandalized.

Fresh flowers wreaths, potted plants, or easel arrangements from a funeral service, should be picked up by the family within a few days after the service, or the cemetery will remove them from the grave site when they become wilted or tattered.

Your cooperation with this policy will help the Tulare Public Cemetery District maintain a clean and safe environment for all those visiting the cemetery.

Any headstone/marker that has any homemade add-ons to the headstone/marker will be removed

A Little About The Tulare Public Cemetery District



Tulare Public Cemetery District was established in 1874. It is located at 900 E. Kern Avenue, Tulare, California 93274. This cemetery is referenced today as the KERN Cemetery and is about 50 acers. The Kern Cemetery held its first board of trustees meeting in April 1889 and its first burial in April 1890.

With the population growth we knew we had to grow with it. On March 1994, The Tulare Public Cemetery District had its first burial at what is known today as North J Cemetery. It is located at 4572 North J Street, Tulare, California 93274 and is about 10 acres with plenty of potential for growth.

Between both cemeteries we now have over 350+ interments per year; consisting of the public within district and out of district.

The Tulare Public Cemetery District strives to provide respectful interment services and assist families with care and consideration in a dignified and pleasant atmosphere to the community we serve within the district and maintain our cemetery grounds.

1. A Certificate of Interment Rights to said property shall not pass to BUYER until the contract balance and other sums due hereunder are fully paid in full. No interment in said property will be allowed until the contract balances and other sums due are fully paid.
2. The BUYER agrees that said Interment Rights are purchased for use and not for speculation or investment. BUYER further agrees and understands that any additional service, merchandise, additions, changes or needs not listed in said contract will require payment 3 (three) working days before the use of the contract, these additions which may include, but will not be limited to:
 - a. If the interment of the deceased is eligible for burial, but is not a resident of the District and owned no property in the District at the time of death, a non-resident fee will be added to the contract purchase.
 - b. If a burial is made on a Saturday, the Saturday Graveside Fee will be added to the contract purchase.
 - c. If at the time of burial an oversize outer burial container is determined to be needed to accommodate the casket, an additional fee will be required for the oversize container and if necessary, an additional lot.
3. *The conveyance and succession for said Interment Rights shall be subject to the California Health and Safety Code Section 9069, Chapter 5.5, Interment Rights and all SELLERS rules and regulations which may be duly adopted in policies, rules, and regulations for governing the use, sale, or other transfer of interment rights.*
4. *If the BUYER is deceased and said contract have not been used for interment, substantial service or merchandise, and have not been sold or gifted by the BUYER, said rights will succeed in the order of Assignment Designation. If no assigned designee makes claim on said Interment Rights, they shall pass according to the laws of intestate succession as set forth in Section 6400 to 6413, inclusive of the California Probate Code.*
5. If this contract is terminated by the BUYER, the SELLER will refund all amounts paid hereunder with the exception of \$ _____, which includes any and all Endowment Care and Administration Fees (if paid) which shall be retained by the SELLER.
6. BUYER shall have the right any time, unless in default hereunder to assign his interest in this agreement to an eligible person, provided such assignment is first recorded on the books of the SELLER and transferred according to the rules and regulations as required by the SELLER.
7. No warranties, expressed or implied, representations, promises, or statements have been made by the SELLER unless endorsed hereon in writing. Tulare Public Cemetery will set-up the gravesite for the burial service with:

- Canopy
- 12 (Twelve) Chairs
- Green Turf around burial opening
- Signs from Funeral home to guide guests to the service

Tulare Public Cemetery will set-up the Niche / Cremation service with:

- Table for Urn set-up
- 6 (Six) Chairs
- Signs from Funeral home to guide guests to the service

Time reserved for your service is 30-45 minutes. Service must be completed and guests starting to depart within that time. Time is limited due to other services scheduled to start and other guests arriving at the cemetery for the next burial. We understand that though it may not be very long at the gravesite, but suggest gathering at a more comfortable place to share memories with each other.

We suggest using every precaution necessary to prevent the spread of COVID-19 during any gatherings. (Please check out the CDC Guidelines Page for information on how you can keep you and your family safe.)

After the service is complete all family, friends and guests must leave premises before we can lower the casket. We are sorry for any inconvenience, but we deem this necessary for the safety of our guests and our grounds crew. Your Funeral Director remains at the burial site until the process of lowering the casket is complete.

Once the grave has been closed the flowers that were at the service will be laid down on top of grave and will remain for approximately 1 - 2 weeks based on the condition of the flowers. If there is anything you would like to keep from the flowers we ask that you remove them after service is complete. After about 2 weeks the flowers will be disposed of.

CONCRETE BASE FOR GRAVE MARKER (HEADSTONE) INFORMATION & AGREEMENT

We are requiring that all graves have a marker/headstone that are in compliance with our Grave Marker Rules and Regulations within a 6 month period no longer than 12 months after an Interment has occurred. As of October 1st, 2021 we are taking payment of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400), for which is included in the total cost of the Interment Rights Fees for the concrete base that a marker/headstone is in or on. We will forward funds to Barnes Memorial along with your information for the plot and you are to contact them for information to order headstone so they can approve based on the Tulare Public Cemetery Rules and Regulations of our Grave Marker Rules.

NO MAKE SHIFT HEADSTONE/MARKERS OR MEMORIALS ARE ALLOWED TO BE PLACED ON GRAVE.

For ½ Baby Grave we are taking payment of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) which does not fully cover the concrete base so you must contact Barnes Memorial to get total due after the \$200 payment. I acknowledge and understand that I must make arrangements with Barnes Memorial on remainder of payment for concrete base and understand that I am still responsible for the headstone/marker purchase. I understand I must have a marker within the 6-12 month period after an interment has been made.

I acknowledge, agree and understand that I am required to place a compliant marker/headstone on the Grave within the 6-12 month period after an interment has been made in the plot. I understand that my payment of \$400 will be sent to Barnes Memorial from Tulare Public Cemetery for the cost of the concrete base ONLY and that I am still responsible for the headstone/marker purchase. If I have not made arrangements with Barnes Memorial prior to the 6-12 month period that after the 12 month a concrete base that was purchase will be placed on the grave with the 2 vases but no personal information about the interred will be on the base.

TULARE PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICT FLOWER POLICY

The following are guidelines for the use of flowers and decorations on the grave sites in the Tulare Public Cemetery District, in order to maintain the cemeteries in an attractive and dignified manner and in order to protect the safety of visitors and the employees on the cemeteries.

FLOWERS AND DECORATIONS MUST BE CONFINED WITHIN THE VASE HOLDERS ON EACH GRAVE SITE MARKER BORDER

There shall not be placed on any grave, crosses, balloons, fences cement vases, borders of the flowers, rocks, wood, metal, statues, toys, decorations, etc, unless they are **confined and secured** as an integral part of the flower arrangement within the vase holders above the grave site marker. Anyone who does not have a marker/headstone cannot have anything on the grave until a marker /headstone is set.

Cemetery staff will remove any of the arrangement that become wilted, tattered, a hazard, or safety issue to anyone visiting the Cemetery.

Tulare Public Cemetery District will take reasonable efforts not to harm arrangements within the site containers and will not be responsible for anything that has broken, lost, stolen misplaced or vandalized.

Fresh flowers wreaths, potted plants, or easel arrangements from a funeral service, should be picked up by the family within a few days after the service, or the cemetery will remove them from the grave site when they become wilted or tattered.

Your cooperation with this policy will help the Tulare Public Cemetery District maintain a clean and safe environment for all those visiting the cemetery.

Any headstone/marker that has any homemade add-ons to the headstone/marker will be removed

DIVISION 6. WILLS AND INTESTATE SUCCESSION [6100 - 6806] (Division 6 enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

PART 2. INTESTATE SUCCESSION [6400 - 6455] (Part 2 enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

CHAPTER 1. Intestate Succession Generally [6400 - 6414] (Heading of Chapter 1 added by Stats. 1993, Ch. 529, Sec. 2.)

6400. Any part of the estate of a decedent not effectively disposed of by will passes to the decedent's heirs as prescribed in this part.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6401. (a) As to community property, the intestate share of the surviving spouse is the one-half of the community property that belongs to the decedent under Section 100.

(b) As to quasi-community property, the intestate share of the surviving spouse is the one-half of the quasi-community property that belongs to the decedent under Section 101.

(c) As to separate property, the intestate share of the surviving spouse is as follows:

(1) The entire intestate estate if the decedent did not leave any surviving issue, parent, brother, sister, or issue of a deceased brother or sister.

(2) One-half of the intestate estate in the following cases:

(A) Where the decedent leaves only one child or the issue of one deceased child.

(B) Where the decedent leaves no issue, but leaves a parent or parents or their issue or the issue of either of them.

(3) One-third of the intestate estate in the following cases:

(A) Where the decedent leaves more than one child.

(B) Where the decedent leaves one child and the issue of one or more deceased children.

(C) Where the decedent leaves issue of two or more deceased children.

(Amended by Stats. 2014, Ch. 913, Sec. 32. (AB 2747) Effective January 1, 2015.)

6402. Except as provided in Section 6402.5, the part of the intestate estate not passing to the surviving spouse, under Section 6401, or the entire intestate estate if there is no surviving spouse, passes as follows:

(a) To the issue of the decedent, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the decedent, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(b) If there is no surviving issue, to the decedent's parent or parents equally.

(c) If there is no surviving issue or parent, to the issue of the parents or either of them, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the decedent, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(d) If there is no surviving issue, parent or issue of a parent, but the decedent is survived by one or more grandparents or issue of grandparents, to the grandparent or grandparents equally, or to the issue of those grandparents if there is no surviving grandparent, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the decedent, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(e) If there is no surviving issue, parent or issue of a parent, grandparent or issue of a grandparent, but the decedent is survived by the issue of a predeceased spouse, to that issue, the issue taking equally if they are all of

the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(f) If there is no surviving issue, parent or issue of a parent, grandparent or issue of a grandparent, or issue of a predeceased spouse, but the decedent is survived by next of kin, to the next of kin in equal degree, but where there are two or more collateral kindred in equal degree who claim through different ancestors, those who claim through the nearest ancestor are preferred to those claiming through an ancestor more remote.

(g) If there is no surviving next of kin of the decedent and no surviving issue of a predeceased spouse of the decedent, but the decedent is survived by the parents of a predeceased spouse or the issue of those parents, to the parent or parents equally, or to the issue of those parents if both are deceased, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(Amended by Stats. 2014, Ch. 913, Sec. 32.5. (AB 2747) Effective January 1, 2015.)

6402.5. (a) For purposes of distributing real property under this section if the decedent had a predeceased spouse who died not more than 15 years before the decedent and there is no surviving spouse or issue of the decedent, the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the decedent's predeceased spouse passes as follows:

(1) If the decedent is survived by issue of the predeceased spouse, to the surviving issue of the predeceased spouse; if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse they take equally, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(2) If there is no surviving issue of the predeceased spouse but the decedent is survived by a parent or parents of the predeceased spouse, to the predeceased spouse's surviving parent or parents equally.

(3) If there is no surviving issue or parent of the predeceased spouse but the decedent is survived by issue of a parent of the predeceased spouse, to the surviving issue of the parents of the predeceased spouse or either of them, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(4) If the decedent is not survived by issue, parent, or issue of a parent of the predeceased spouse, to the next of kin of the decedent in the manner provided in Section 6402.

(5) If the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the decedent's predeceased spouse would otherwise escheat to the state because there is no kin of the decedent to take under Section 6402, the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the predeceased spouse passes to the next of kin of the predeceased spouse who shall take in the same manner as the next of kin of the decedent take under Section 6402.

(b) For purposes of distributing personal property under this section if the decedent had a predeceased spouse who died not more than five years before the decedent, and there is no surviving spouse or issue of the decedent, the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the decedent's predeceased spouse passes as follows:

(1) If the decedent is survived by issue of the predeceased spouse, to the surviving issue of the predeceased spouse; if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse they take equally, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(2) If there is no surviving issue of the predeceased spouse but the decedent is survived by a parent or parents of the predeceased spouse, to the predeceased spouse's surviving parent or parents equally.

(3) If there is no surviving issue or parent of the predeceased spouse but the decedent is survived by issue of a parent of the predeceased spouse, to the surviving issue of the parents of the predeceased spouse or either of them, the issue taking equally if they are all of the same degree of kinship to the predeceased spouse, but if of unequal degree those of more remote degree take in the manner provided in Section 240.

(4) If the decedent is not survived by issue, parent, or issue of a parent of the predeceased spouse, to the next of kin of the decedent in the manner provided in Section 6402.

(5) If the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the decedent's predeceased spouse would otherwise escheat to the state because there is no kin of the decedent to take under Section 6402, the portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the predeceased spouse passes to the next of kin of the predeceased spouse who shall take in the same manner as the next of kin of the decedent take under Section 6402.

(c) For purposes of disposing of personal property under subdivision (b), the claimant heir bears the burden of proof to show the exact personal property to be disposed of to the heir.

(d) For purposes of providing notice under any provision of this code with respect to an estate that may include personal property subject to distribution under subdivision (b), if the aggregate fair market value of tangible and intangible personal property with a written record of title or ownership in the estate is believed in good faith by the

petitioning party to be less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), the petitioning party need not give notice to the issue or next of kin of the predeceased spouse. If the personal property is subsequently determined to have an aggregate fair market value in excess of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), notice shall be given to the issue or next of kin of the predeceased spouse as provided by law.

(e) For the purposes of disposing of property pursuant to subdivision (b), "personal property" means that personal property in which there is a written record of title or ownership and the value of which in the aggregate is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more.

(f) For the purposes of this section, the "portion of the decedent's estate attributable to the decedent's predeceased spouse" means all of the following property in the decedent's estate:

(1) One-half of the community property in existence at the time of the death of the predeceased spouse.

(2) One-half of any community property, in existence at the time of death of the predeceased spouse, which was given to the decedent by the predeceased spouse by way of gift, descent, or devise.

(3) That portion of any community property in which the predeceased spouse had any incident of ownership and which vested in the decedent upon the death of the predeceased spouse by right of survivorship.

(4) Any separate property of the predeceased spouse which came to the decedent by gift, descent, or devise of the predeceased spouse or which vested in the decedent upon the death of the predeceased spouse by right of survivorship.

(g) For the purposes of this section, quasi-community property shall be treated the same as community property.

(h) For the purposes of this section:

(1) Relatives of the predeceased spouse conceived before the decedent's death but born thereafter inherit as if they had been born in the lifetime of the decedent.

(2) A person who is related to the predeceased spouse through two lines of relationship is entitled to only a single share based on the relationship which would entitle the person to the larger share.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6403. (a) A person who fails to survive the decedent by 120 hours is deemed to have predeceased the decedent for the purpose of intestate succession, and the heirs are determined accordingly. If it cannot be established by clear and convincing evidence that a person who would otherwise be an heir has survived the decedent by 120 hours, it is deemed that the person failed to survive for the required period. The requirement of this section that a person who survives the decedent must survive the decedent by 120 hours does not apply if the application of the 120-hour survival requirement would result in the escheat of property to the state.

(b) This section does not apply to the case where any of the persons upon whose time of death the disposition of property depends died before January 1, 1990, and such case continues to be governed by the law applicable before January 1, 1990.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6404. Part 4 (commencing with Section 6800) (escheat) applies if there is no taker of the intestate estate under the provisions of this part.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6406. Except as provided in Section 6451, relatives of the halfblood inherit the same share they would inherit if they were of the whole blood.

(Amended by Stats. 1993, Ch. 529, Sec. 3. Effective January 1, 1994.)

6407. Relatives of the decedent conceived before the decedent's death but born thereafter inherit as if they had been born in the lifetime of the decedent.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6409. (a) If a person dies intestate as to all or part of his or her estate, property the decedent gave during lifetime to an heir is treated as an advancement against that heir's share of the intestate estate only if one of the following conditions is satisfied:

(1) The decedent declares in a contemporaneous writing that the gift is an advancement against the heir's share of the estate or that its value is to be deducted from the value of the heir's share of the estate.

(2) The heir acknowledges in writing that the gift is to be so deducted or is an advancement or that its value is to be deducted from the value of the heir's share of the estate.

(b) Subject to subdivision (c), the property advanced is to be valued as of the time the heir came into possession or enjoyment of the property or as of the time of death of the decedent, whichever occurs first.

(c) If the value of the property advanced is expressed in the contemporaneous writing of the decedent, or in an acknowledgment of the heir made contemporaneously with the advancement, that value is conclusive in the division and distribution of the intestate estate.

(d) If the recipient of the property advanced fails to survive the decedent, the property is not taken into account in computing the intestate share to be received by the recipient's issue unless the declaration or acknowledgment provides otherwise.

(Amended by Stats. 2002, Ch. 138, Sec. 8. Effective January 1, 2003.)

6410. (a) A debt owed to the decedent is not charged against the intestate share of any person except the debtor.

(b) If the debtor fails to survive the decedent, the debt is not taken into account in computing the intestate share of the debtor's issue.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6411. No person is disqualified to take as an heir because that person or a person through whom he or she claims is or has been an alien.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6412. Except to the extent provided in Section 120, the estates of dower and curtesy are not recognized.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6413. A person who is related to the decedent through two lines of relationship is entitled to only a single share based on the relationship which would entitle the person to the larger share.

(Enacted by Stats. 1990, Ch. 79.)

6414. (a) Except as provided in subdivision (b), this part does not apply where the decedent died before January 1, 1985, and the law applicable prior to January 1, 1985, continues to apply where the decedent died before January 1, 1985.

(b) Section 6412 applies whether the decedent died before, on, or after January 1, 1985.

(c) Where any of the following provisions is applied in a case where the decedent died before January 1, 1985, any reference in that provision to this part shall be deemed to be a reference to former Division 2 (commencing with Section 200) which was repealed by Section 19 of Chapter 842 of the Statutes of 1983:

(1) Section 377 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

(2) Section 3524 of the Penal Code.

CHAPTER 5.5. Interment Rights [9069.10 - 9069.40] (*Chapter 5.5 added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2.*)

[9069.10.](#) An interment right does not include the right for disinterment of human remains except on consent of the cemetery district and the written consent of the surviving spouse, child, parent, or sibling, in that order of priority. (Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

[9069.15.](#) (a) This chapter does not apply to, or prohibit, the removal of remains from one plot to another in the same cemetery or the removal of remains by a cemetery district upon the written order of any of the following:

- (1) The superior court of the county in which the cemetery is located.
- (2) The coroner having jurisdiction of the location of the cemetery.
- (3) The health department having jurisdiction of the cemetery.

(b) The cemetery district shall maintain a duplicate copy of an order pursuant to subdivision (a).

(c) The cemetery district shall retain a true and correct record of a removal of remains pursuant to subdivision (a) that includes all of the following:

- (1) The date the remains were removed.
- (2) The name and the age at death of the person whose remains were removed if available.
- (3) The cemetery and plot from which the remains were removed.
- (4) (A) If the removed remains are reinterred, the plot number, cemetery name, and location to which the remains were reinterred.
- (B) If the removed remains are disposed of other than by being reinterred, a record of the alternate disposition.
- (5) If the removed remains are reinterred at the cemetery, the date of reinterment.
- (d) The person making the removal shall deliver to the cemetery district operating the cemetery from which the remains were removed a true, full, and complete copy of the record containing all of the information specified in subdivision (c).

(Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

[9069.20.](#) (a) An interment right provides a transferable property interest to the person listed as the owner in the records of the cemetery district, subject to any written designation to the contrary signed by the owner and deposited with the cemetery district, or to the owner's successor pursuant to either this section or subdivision (a) of Section 9069.25. An interment right shall not be construed as conferring title to the property burdened by the transferable property interest.

(b) The owner of record of an interment right may designate in writing the person or persons, other than the owner of record, who may be interred in the plot to which the owner holds the interment right.

(c) The owner of an interment right shall, at the time of purchase, designate a successor owner or owners of the interment right in a signed written designation deposited with the district.

(d) Use of an interment right transferred from the owner to a successor pursuant to subdivision (c) shall be made in compliance with applicable provisions of state and local law, and of applicable requirements or policies established by the district board of trustees.

(Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

9069.25. (a) If the owner of an interment right dies without making a valid and enforceable disposition of the interment right by a specific devise in a testamentary device, or by a written designation pursuant to subdivision (c) of Section 9069.20, the interment right shall pass according to the laws of intestate succession as set forth in Sections 6400 to 6413, inclusive, of the Probate Code. In the event that the owner has no heirs at law, the district shall follow the abandonment procedures established under Section 9069.

(b) A surviving spouse, registered domestic partner, child, parent, or heir who has an interment right pursuant to this section may waive that interment right in favor of any other relative of the deceased owner or spouse of a relative of the deceased owner.

(Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

9069.30. When a public cemetery district acts to transfer ownership rights or make an interment on the basis of the affidavit, given under penalty of perjury pursuant to Section 9069.35, the district, and any employee or trustee of the district, shall not be liable for any claims, losses, or damages asserted in any action unless the district had actual knowledge that the facts stated in writing are false.

(Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

9069.35. A person who purports to be the successor owner of an interment right shall execute a written affidavit declaring, under penalty of perjury, all of the following:

(a) He or she is the person entitled to succeed to the interment right pursuant to Section 9069.20.

(b) He or she has exerted all reasonable efforts to find other persons who may have an equal or higher claim to succeed to the interment right.

(c) He or she is unaware, to the best of his or her knowledge, of any opposition challenging his or her right to succeed to the interment right.

(Added by Stats. 2016, Ch. 592, Sec. 2. (SB 1179) Effective January 1, 2017.)

9069.40. Upon the sale to a person of a plot in a cemetery within a district, the district shall notify the purchaser, in writing, of any interment rights, that this chapter governs the succession of ownership of the interment rights, and the district's duly adopted policies, rules, and regulations governing the use, sale, or other transfer of interment rights.

When I buy a plot, do I own the land?

No. As an Interment Rights Holder ("Rights Holder") what you own is an "interment right." This gives you the right to determine who can be buried in your grave, crypt, or niche and what memorialization, if any, will be placed there, providing it's permitted within the cemetery's bylaws. The land remains the property of the cemetery and its responsibility too.

What happens when the registered Interments Right Holder dies?

If a sole owner dies, he or she can be automatically buried in the interment right and any future interest in the right becomes part of the sole owner's estate. If a joint owner dies, the surviving Rights Holder(s) have to give their permission for the burial as well as placing or inscribing a memorial. Any future interest in the interment rights then automatically goes to the remaining surviving owners.

Can I pre-authorize who can be buried within the interment rights?

Yes, an Allocation document in which the Rights Holder pre-authorizes who can be buried in the future, specifies the location of the burials. The document also allows memorialization for those named and can be completed with the cemetery office. Having this document in place avoids having to obtain permission or direction at the time of an interment.

Can anyone in my family use the grave/crypt/niche/urn space?

Anyone – they don't have to be in your family - can make use of a grave, crypt, niche or urn space, but the written permission of the registered Rights Holder/s is required.

What happens if the Interment Rights Holder has a legal name change?

The cemetery office will require proof of the name change so that our records can be updated. Proof can be one of the following:

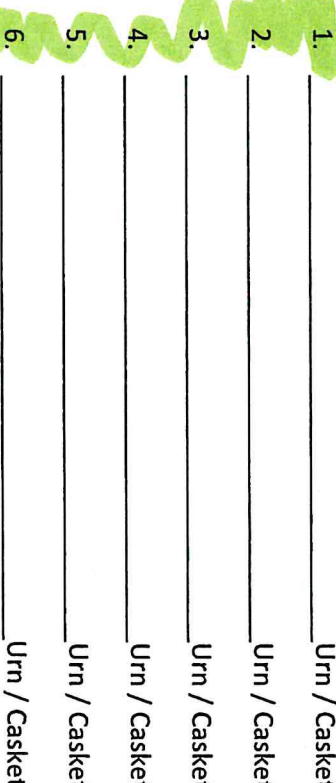

THIS ARTICLE SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, OR CORPORATION HOLDING A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY AS A CEMETERY, CREMATORY LICENSE, CEMETERY BROKER'S LICENSE, CEMETERY SALESPERSON'S LICENSE, OR FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE, NOR SHALL THIS ARTICLE APPLY TO ANY PERSON HAVING THE RIGHT TO CONTROL THE DISPOSITION OF THE CREMATED REMAINS OF ANY PERSON OR THAT PERSON'S DESIGNEE IF THE PERSON DOES NOT DISPOSE OF OR OFFER TO DISPOSE OF MORE THAN 10 CREMATED HUMAN REMAINS WITHIN ANY CALENDAR YEAR. (BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS CODE SECTION 9740.)

CREMATED REMAINS MAY BE SCATTERED IN AREAS WHERE NO LOCAL PROHIBITION EXISTS, PROVIDED THAT THE CREMATED REMAINS ARE NOT DISTINGUISHABLE TO THE PUBLIC, ARE NOT IN A CONTAINER, AND THAT THE PERSON WHO HAS CONTROL OVER DISPOSITION OF THE CREMATED REMAINS HAS OBTAINED WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE PROPERTY OWNER OR GOVERNING AGENCY TO SCATTER ON THE PROPERTY.
